

Old Business:

- a. Frank Sodek Jr. contacted the Corps of Engineers regarding tree trimming at the flying field. The Park Ranger indicated he would be willing to meet at the field to review the offending trees. Frank also informed us that the Corps has been working on getting electricity to the new gate attendant area at the entrance of McGregor Park.
- b. One free subscription to Model Aviation is available for clubs to donate to high schools; Frank has been working to set up a subscription for Temple High School and a paid subscription to The Temple Public Library and Belton High School.
- John Rovetto has inspected the mower cowl and reported that it will need some parts to reattach it.
- d. The Fall Picnic was deemed a success and everyone enjoyed the Scottish eggs. We had great weather

- e. Buster Hinkle reported on the Fall Fun Fly and announced that the club has a new mascot, a small doe. It appears the local wildlife is interested in model aviation too!
- f. Daylight Savings Time has ended and Beginners'
 Night is officially on hold until next spring. We had a
 record number of pilots learning to fly this past
 summer that kept all the flight instructors very busy.
- g. Mark Cullison reported on the last Combat event of the year, we had great participation this year.

New Business:

- a. The Santa Pal Fly In will be held on December 2nd this year. B. W. Ponder will be the CD for the event which will start around 1:00pm on Sunday. The entry fee for the event is a new unwrapped toy, suggested value of \$10.
- b. The Christmas Banquet is coming up, we will have a pot luck dinner, elect club officers and then have the Chinese Gift Exchange.
- A Nominating Committee has been formed and will get a list of "Nominees" ready for the November Newsletter.
- d. Frank Sodek Jr. announced to the club his intention of nominating Mark Cullison for the Dirty Dozen Award. Frank noted that Mark has gone out of his way to be available every Wednesday for Beginners' Night flight training. Mark has been the Newsletter Editor since 1994 and is also the Combat CD.
- The next Temple Aero Modelers club meeting will be held in the Board Room of the Temple Public Library at 7:30pm.

- a. Frank awarded John Rovetto and John Redwine one ATTABOY each for providing a Fajita lunch during our last Combat event. John and John said they wanted to say thanks to all the instructors for teaching all the beginners how to fly.
- Mark Cullison collected an ATTABOY from Frank for all the work he does assembling the newsletters each month.
- c. The Killeen club has opted not to have a Big Bird event next year; attendance to these events has been slowly declining.

- d. The Georgetown club had a Poker Fly In and reported that they had 21 participants.
- e. The Georgetown club will be having a swap meet January 18th and 19th.

- Frank Sodek, Jr. was flying Derek Ward on a buddy box when the plane froze up. It flew a slowly descending spiral until it crashed. The transmitter battery was dead.


