

Woohoo, we pulled off another safe and successful Airshow! I want to thank Fred Huber for coordinating this year's Airshow again for our club, because it really takes a lot of hard work to pull off an event like this successfully. We

had decent weather for Friday night and during the day Saturday, but the winds got really strong on Sunday which prevented us from performing our flying demonstration. The flying demonstrations on Friday night and Saturday went very well, even though the new safety rules pushed the flightline far out from the spectators. I heard many positive comments about the night flyers. Ron Norman began the show with his Giant Stinger that had bright LEDs all around it, then Fred was joined by Larry Macie, Ron Elza and David Macek flying their electric brightly-lit (with colored LEDs) delta foamies. Ron then finished off the night flying demo with another flight on his Stinger, when it had gotten darker. On Saturday Ron gave a very impressive flight with his giant Sukhoi, performing some great aerobatics while showing off his most impressive smoke system. Tim Symonds then flew his twin electric-powered P-61 Black Widow to complete the flying demonstration on Saturday.

Raffle ticket sales over the three days were down compared to last year. The winner of the P-51 raffle plane was Mr. Bud Owens from Hamilton. The second place winner of the quadcopter was Paul Sullivan from Belton. I want to thank Max Blose from the Waco Hobby Stop for generously donating the quadcopter to our raffle. We also had a decent static display of planes and a helicopter this year, which got lots of attention from spectators. Thanks to everyone that helped at the show, including those who spent a lot of time selling raffle tickets and answering questions about our club and hobby.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> - was read by Buster Hinkle, Treasurer; a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report was made by Pete Cornett, 2nd by Fred Huber.

<u>Safety Officer's Report</u> – David mentioned that everyone should be careful if going out to look for planes out in the brush by themselves, and also suggested that someone should always remain behind to watch over all the aircraft and equipment in the pits, in case a visitor drives up.

Field Marshal's Report – Ed mentioned that the new riding mower was low on oil when he checked it before mowing the infield before the Spring Picnic. Every member should remember to always check the oil before starting the mower. It was also mentioned that Cliff's memorial marker is sinking into the ground, and needs to be worked on. Frank mentioned that John Redwine got a quote to repair the entrance gate column for \$300. A motion to spend \$300 for the repair of the entrance gate was made by Fred, 2nd by Larry, and the motion passed.

<u>Blunder Awards</u> – Ron Norman crashed his Giant Stinger when his engine died at a bad spot. Fred crashed his new electric ME-262 because the battery fell out. Fred won the Blunder Award this month.
